Identify, promote and reward the best LOM future actions during the European Conference.

The DNA of JCI is action within our territories in connection with the global goals. Every year, many relevant actions are carried out throughout Europe and some are rewarded.

As an incubator for innovative citizen projects, the **Association of JCI Senators in Europe (ASE)** wants with the "**European conference golden nuggets**" animation to give a boost to a project, to a "nugget" in the making, in other words to an action that has not yet had its D-Day.

When

1. Before May, 27th > **Receipt** of the **application forms**.
2. May, 28th > June, 3rd > **Review** of the forms and **selection** of 10 projects. Each member of the jury will have an **evaluation grid with 3 criteria: relevance, argumentation and innovation**.
3. June, 04th > **Publication** of the 10 short listed projects.
4. During the European conference, the 10 selected LOMs/ projects will have **3 minutes to present their action**, followed by a **question-and-answer session** with a panel of senators and JCI officers.

Each member of the jury will have an **evaluation grid** with **4 criteria: relevance, argumentation, innovation and questions/answers** with the jury.

The project with the most points will be rewarded. In the event of a tie, the innovation criterion will prevail.

Award

At the end of the ranking, the best rated action will receive a **registration fee for the European Conference 2022 in Bruges** (Belgium), which corresponds to approximately 450 €.

The 10 short listed projects will be **publicized and promoted** on the different media of our association for potential partnerships.

The results and the award will be presented during a **general assembly** of the conference.

How

The project must meet 2 criteria:

- to be **linked to the UN global goals**
- **not to be completed**

It must also include the planned **start and end dates** of the project.

The form must be:

- a **single page**,
- in **English**,
- with a **minimum character of 10**,
- sent in **pdf format**.
