- 6. Matters arising from the last meeting/minutes

 - GLC needs to know before AGM in June which countries has paid the fee (if not paid, cannot vote).

Charlotte said that we need clear instructions what to do, how to act. JCI does not help us with GDPR because JCI is based in USA (Pelin's question). Max contacted the Belgium Senate if the pre-tour is organised before EC Bruges, not a good response. The EC 2023 in Bucharest no news yet who will take of Senators. SEKO will be in Braunschweig (Max will be the host), he will attend the Lofoten and Bruges.

He was a long-time secretary general for Senate in Norway, he has also worked for JCI in Miami. Aud told that there has not been any activity with the other regions and their presidents.
