Current Activities – May 2022 - November 2023

- The Board has had one Zoom Meeting
- A National Senate Presidents 'Forum was held in Bucharest
- Board members again have responsibility for liaising with and supporting assigned countries thus creating a better links with National Senate Organisations and our individual members
- Productive relationship with 2023 EVP for Europe has been developed
- Some members of the ASE Board joined one of the weekly JCI Europe Zoom meetings to outline and discuss possible ways that Senators can assist the active members and develop JCI in the countries of Europe
- An ASE Summer Experience was held in Belgrade and an ASE Autumn Experience was held in conjunction with the JCI Ireland Convention in Galway
- The Constitution is being reviewed
- Ensuring GDPR compliance in all that we do is a major activity
